I'll discuss the recent connections between ignorance of high complexity, subdominant saddles in the gravitational replica trick, and Hawking's calculation in the context of the "strong" Python's Lunch proposal. I will further argue both in the classical and semiclassical regimes that nonminimal quantum extremal surfaces are the exclusive source of exponential complexity in the AdS/CFT dictionary.
